## Jonah 1:17-2:10 (ESV)

<sup>17</sup> And the LORD appointed a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

<sup>1</sup> Then Jonah prayed to the LORD his God from the belly of the fish, <sup>2</sup> saying,

"I called out to the LORD, out of my distress,

and he answered me;

out of the belly of Sheol I cried,

and you heard my voice.

<sup>3</sup> For you cast me into the deep, into the heart of the seas, and the flood surrounded me;

all your waves and your billows

passed over me.

<sup>4</sup>Then I said, 'I am driven away from your sight;

yet I shall again look

upon your holy temple.'

<sup>5</sup> The waters closed in over me to take my life;

the deep surrounded me;

weeds were wrapped about my head

<sup>6</sup> at the roots of the mountains.

I went down to the land

whose bars closed upon me forever;

yet you brought up my life from the pit,

O LORD my God.

<sup>7</sup> When my life was fainting away,

I remembered the LORD,

and my prayer came to you,

into your holy temple.

<sup>8</sup> Those who pay regard to vain idols forsake their hope of steadfast love.

<sup>9</sup> But I with the voice of thanksgiving

will sacrifice to you;

what I have vowed I will pay.

Salvation belongs to the LORD!"

 $^{10}$  And the LORD spoke to the fish, and it vomited Jonah out upon the dry land.

## An Invitation to see ourselves as we really are (v. 2:1-10)

Something is right (v. 2:1-2, 4, 5-10)

"Death is an abstraction to us, something technically true but unimaginable as a personal reality." (Timothy Keller, "Growing My Faith in the Face of Death," *The Atlantic*, March 7, 2021)

Something is wrong (v. 2:3-4, 8-10)

"It is...all too possible to have an evangelical head and a legalistic heart." (Sinclair Ferguson, The Whole Christ, 94)

Matthew 20:13-15 (ESV)

<sup>13</sup> But he replied to one of them, "Friend, I am doing you no wrong. Did you not agree with me for a denarius? <sup>14</sup> Take what belongs to you and go. I choose to give to this last worker as I give to you. <sup>15</sup> Am I not allowed to do what I choose with what belongs to me? Or do you begrudge my generosity?"

Leviticus 18:28 (ESV)

<sup>28</sup> lest the land vomit you out when you make it unclean, as it vomited out the nation that was before you.
