John 17:20-26 (ESV)

²⁰ I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word,

²¹ that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

²² The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one,

²³ I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.

²⁴ Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world.

²⁵ O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me.

²⁶ I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them.

Notes:

Reasons why He wants us to see His glory:

- 1. You have seen His humiliation.
- 2. He wants you to see who He really is.
- 3. He wants you to see how much His Father loves Him who would give Him such glory.
- 4. He wants you to know how much His Father loves you.
- 5. He wants you to know how much you have meant to Him.
- 6. He wants you to know at the end of the day it would have all been worth it.
- 7. He wants you, which is why He died for you!
